

## Women Only Race Day – February 17, 2007

*[All events qualify for the Women's Cycling Challenge Track Series.]*

**Where:** The ADT Event Center Velodrome at the Home Depot Center in Carson, CA.

Enter the Home Depot Center from the Avalon Avenue entrance. See [www.homedepotcenter.com](http://www.homedepotcenter.com) for driving directions. Free limited parking in the ADT Event Center lot. Additional parking is available in remote Home Depot Center lots. **Parking in CSUDH lots requires an additional parking fee!**

**When:** Saturday, February 17, 2007, with racing to start at 10:00 a.m.

The track will open at 8:30 a.m. for registration and warm-up.

**Who:** All USAC licensed female racers who are eligible to race at the ADT.

To be eligible, you must be a Category 1 or 2 licensed rider, or already hold the ADT Velodrome Certification. **NO exceptions!!**

**Categories:** W Cat 1/2 ; W Cat 3; W Cat 4; W Masters 40+; W Masters 50+; Juniors (Girls).

A USA Cycling license is required. **No** one-day licenses will be issued. Licenses may be obtained on-line at [www.usacycling.org](http://www.usacycling.org).

Any field with more than 12 riders may be split at the discretion of the race co-promoter. Any field with less than 5 riders may be merged with another field at the discretion of the race co-promoter.

**Entry Fee:** \$10, plus track fee for Seniors and Masters. Juniors race free, and pay only the track fee.

Track fee is \$20, or one check off a Club Session Card. Club Session Cards are available from Roger Young – [ADTeventcenter@aol.com](mailto:ADTeventcenter@aol.com)

**NOTE: Rental bikes will NOT be available on race day. Racers will be expected to provide their own bicycles.**

**Other:** Racers may enter the velodrome through the south entrance, and set up bikes on the infield. Access to the track is available by a ramp. **Do NOT cross the track without permission from the Velodrome Management!**

**Prize Lists and Omnium Race Schedule will be announced the day of the race.**
